1) When did you first begin expressing yourself creatively and how?

The world is funny if you know how to look at it. Inspiration happens when you don't want it to, so always have a pen handy.

3) What work are you currently most proud of?

I get to perform weekly at a smaller comedy club in LA. It's something that not only makes me a stronger comedian, but it gives me bragging rights are fun too.

4) What advice would you give to others about the creative side of what you do?

Be honest about your flaws. You're not perfect and no one is. This could be a skill you're not good at, or issues you have in your own head. If you can't embrace what you fail at, you can't get better. It's true for almost anything, but especially in the arts.

5) What advice would you give to others about the business side of what you do?

It's not easy to traverse. It's not fun. And it makes me cry a lot. The business side is the double-edged sword that makes it possible to make money and to die hungry.
